Officers will report at Caterloo Station at 3.45 P.M. to-day, July 26th, for the purpose of proceeding on a Military Special to the Port of Embarkation.

A Canadian Military Patigue party will be on duty at the Station between the hours of 12 Noon and 3.45 P.M. for the purpose of assisting Officers in the handling of their heavy baggage.

All baggage should be labelled either "Wanted" or "Hold". The "Hold" baggage will be placed on board ship at the Port of Embarkation but it will be the responsibility of the Officers to take care of the "Wanted" baggage that they will require during the voyage.

The above arrangements for baggage are offered as a convenience to the Officers in view of the present difficulty of obtaining Porters etc., but this Department in no way assumes any responsibility as to the loss of same.

Officers will be required to go on board ship immediately on arrival at the Port, at which time white embarkation cards will be given to the Embarkation authorities on the gangway.

Officers wives will be permitted to accompany their Husbands on this Military Special but must be in possession of a Railway ticket.
